POSITION SPECIFICATIONS

Education: High school diploma required

Experience: Minimum of 1 year in work environment

Prerequisite Skills:

- Accurate typing of 40 WPM, basic skill in word processing, demonstrated verbal communication skills
- Demonstrated interpersonal skills to effectively and courteously work with staff and the community
- Ability to organize work, seek feedback, and make revisions
- Ability to operate computer, fax machine, copier, and calculator

Time/Salary:

- Student is expected to commit to 9 month school calendar
- 3 6 hours per week allotted; average is 4 hours per week
- Salary will meet minimum wage. Timesheet will be submitted to the manager

Responsibilities:

- Identify projects and prepare outline of project complete with timeline to be reviewed with supervisors on schedule agreed by intern and staff
- Submit quarterly reports on projects
- Attend meetings as requested by supervisors and as Intern schedule and interest allows
- Remain in contact by email when not on site
- Serve as liaison with other diabetes management (DM) resource groups in the community (i.e. JDRF, T1 Marin, Carb DM)
